STUDY AND LEARN CATALAN



Don't make excuses!

Here you will find all levels of learning the Catalan language. From the most basic, to begin with, to the highest, for perfection.

There are classroom and online courses; 6-monthly and annually, and even self-study courses to learn at your own pace.

Adult education centres

The courses are annual and start in September.

Centres in Palma:

Municipal Adult Education Service - PalmaEduca / Institut d'Estudis Baleàrics

Catalan courses at different levels organised. Courses normally begin twice a year: after summer and after Christmas.

Official Language School

Offers 4-month and annual courses and exams leading to official certificates.

UIB Language Services

They teach courses with a final exam and an official certificate, and are aimed at university students and workers, as well as people from outside the university.

EBAP (Escola Balear d'Administració Pública)

If you work for local government, the Balearic School of Public Administration (EBAP) offers you courses, workshops and training in Catalan. They are intended for Balearic Islands government (CAIB) staff and other public bodies and administrations.

OTHER PLATFORMS TO LEARN CATALAN



PELC

This free programme, promoted by the Institut d'Estudis Baleàrics, is a self-learning language resource accessed online.

VIRTUAL CATALAN CENTRE

This is a self-learning tool from the Institut d'Estudis Baleàrics with educational resources distributed by levels, from initial A1 to administrative language. There is also a team of consultants to respond to linguistic questions and queries or review written expressions. Online conversation sessions of any level are also held.

UOC

Apart from learning Catalan online, you can also prepare for exams leading to obtaining an official Catalan certificate; these are held twice a year.

PARAULA

This is a private language services centre offering short practical workshops in oral and written expression to prepare for level exams.





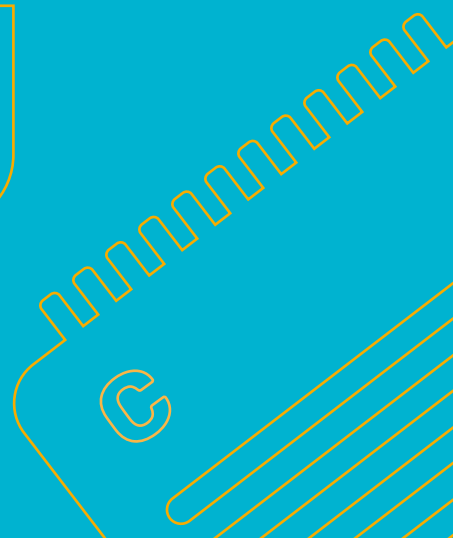
GET A CERTIFICATE

Did you know you need to know Catalan to work in local government? Moreover, having a higher level than required usually counts in your favour.

After doing the course, take full advantage by taking the exam to get the certificate. There are usually examination sessions held twice a year when the courses end. You can also prepare for them freely at your own pace!

You can access the media in Catalan. IB3 TV, IB3 Radio, Ona Mediterrània and the newspaper ARABalears will keep you up to date in Catalan.

Do you play games in Catalan?

This is a campaign from the Balearic Islands Government's General Directorate for Language Policy, providing a list of games in Catalan and their points of sale. You can also find websites and apps to play online.

KEEP PRACTICING CATALAN

Aparella't (Pair up)



This is a free app to find a language partner, developed by the *Plataforma per la Llengua*. The mobile app makes it easier and more fun to find a person to talk to in the language.

With you, in Catalan

Language volunteering campaign, coordinated by *Paraula*. It puts a Catalan speaker in contact with another who has just started to learn and wants to practise.

For the little ones

Cantem, a compilation of 49 traditional songs, and *Vocabulari Llonguet in imatges*, both from the Palma City Council Education and Language Policy Area.

PALMA CITY COUNCIL LANGUAGE SERVICES

Language Dynamisation Service

- ✓ Contact this service for information or guidance on resources to learn, practise or improve your use of Catalan.
- ✓ It promotes different actions to increase the profile of Catalan in services, associations and entities, and helps launch projects and activities fomenting the Catalan language.
- ✓ Education, leisure time, business and immigrants are its main areas of involvement.

Language Advisory Service

This offers:

- ✓ Text correction in Catalan (see conditions).
- ✓ Resolution of language doubts.
- ✓ Information on language legislation and rights, Catalan courses and standardisation campaigns.
- ✓ Specific corrections for companies (websites, advertising texts or specialist vocabulary).

CONSELL DE MALLORCA LINGUISTIC STANDARDISATION SERVICE

This promotes linguistic standardisation in conferences and courses, online resources, applications for grants to promote the use of the language, an advisory service and campaigns to expand the presence of Catalan.



BALEARIC ISLANDS GOVERNMENT GENERAL DIRECTORATE OF LANGUAGE POLICY

Its functions are to:

- ✓ Standardise the Catalan language via activities, conferences and applications for grants and other campaigns.
- ✓ Promote and defend language rights.
- ✓ Certify and provide official approval for the knowledge of Catalan.

INSTITUT D'ESTUDIS BALEÀRICS

This is a Balearic Islands government body dedicated to the promotion of the language and culture of the Balearic Islands. Its language area offers numerous ways to learn Catalan: e.g. courses, resources, workshops and Catalan centres.

MALLORCA LITERÀRIA FOUNDATION

This is a cultural foundation responsible for managing and promoting the literary heritage in Majorca with numerous information projects. Check out its programme of activities dedicated to the promotion of literary creation, the dissemination of written literature in Majorca and the promotion of reading.

LANGUAGE RIGHTS DEFENCE BODY

This Balearic Islands organisation is responsible for the defence and promotion of language rights for the Balearic Islands public.

Offers


- ✓ A translation and proofreading service and linguistic advice.
